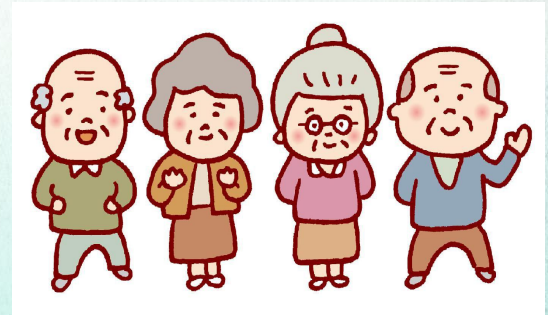


Background:

- Late 2019, many rumours and misinformation about COVID-19
- Ethnic Minorities and Elderly-Vulnerable groups but less access

Objective:

- Reaching out these 2 groups in a rapid manner
- Providing scientific information
- Improving people's knowledge and ability



What have we done:

- Visiting households to deliver health education and free hygiene pack or self-collection in clinics
- 5 key areas to conducting health education
- 4500 non- Chinese ethnic minorities and adults
- 1000 elderlies
- 3000 received COVID-19 anti-epidemic package
- 681 telephone calls
